## **Accreditation and Related Activity**

### **Accreditation Review of the Forest Ecology and Management Major, Ecosystem Science and Management Program, College of Science and Management, University of Northern British Columbia**

Following consideration of the report of the accreditation review team and related documentation, the Canadian Forestry Accreditation Board has determined that accreditation of the Forest Ecology and Management Major, Ecosystem Science and Management Program, College of Science and Management, University of Northern British Columbia, shall be granted for a period of six years. In making its decision, the Board determined that the current program meets the criteria for accreditation established by the CFAB Policy Statement and the applicable Academic Standards.

The determination is subject to all relevant provisions of the Policy Statement which declares that, among others, "the term of the accreditation is subject to review for cause at any time". Accreditation shall begin with the 2009/2010 academic year and shall continue to June 30, 2015, or for as long as the subject program is in effect, whichever is of shorter duration. ### **Accreditation Review of the Forest Management and Environment and Forest Operations Programs, Faculty of Forestry, Geography and Geomatics, Université Laval**

Following consideration of the report of the accreditation review team and related documentation, the Canadian Forestry Accreditation Board has determined that accreditation of the Forest Management and Environment Program and the Forest Operations Program, Faculty of Forestry, Geography and Geomatics, Université Laval shall be granted for a period of six years. In making its decision, the Board determined that the current programs meets the criteria for accreditation established by the CFAB Policy Statement and the applicable Academic Standards.

The determination is subject to all relevant provisions of the Policy Statement which declares that, among others, "the term of the accreditation is subject to review for cause at any time". Accreditation shall begin with the 2009/2010 academic year and shall continue to June 30, 2015, or for as long as the subject program is in effect, whichever is of shorter duration. [September, 2009]

By decision of the Canadian Federation of Professional Foresters Associations (CFPFA), the Laval programs were reviewed using the CFAB academic standards dated March 30, 2000 (now replaced outside Quebec) whereas the UNBC program was reviewed using the new, competency-based standards approved by the CFAB member agencies in 2008 (November 24, 2008).
